In conjunction with the paper mill equipment relocation project for a Vietnamese client, HSB International is also managing the demolition of the paper mill buildings and clean-up of the site in Eastern Quebec.

The mill site is quite extensive and was originally established as a pulp mill around 1900, so the demolition entails a combination of old and new building structures with many different construction materials and techniques. Also, the removal of contamination and asbestos materials will affect the demolition work.

The demolition contractor and dismantling team will be required to work together in order to remove certain pieces of equipment and tanks. Because the equipment must be completely removed and all utilities disconnected in the buildings

before demolition may take place, a strict schedule for the dismantling and removal of equipment must be followed.

The demolition is part of a global project. Along with the relocation of the paper mill equipment, HSB is to provide the conceptual and detail engineering.
